

rganized by Hong Kong Jewelry Manufacturers' Association (HKJMA), The 22nd International Jewelry Manufacturers' Show opens today as a sourcing and sale platform, offering visitors a chance to admire exquisite pieces from around the globe.

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First held with only tens of exhibitors at the HKJMA office, the Show has transformed into a significant international exhibition throughout the years, and has attracted exhibitors from China, Japan Thailand, Korea, Italy, Belgium, Taiwan,

Following the huge success in 2013, HKJMA is making a glorious return this year with an expansion of over 1,000 booths with 659 exhibitors from 17 countries. Three new pavilions are also launched including the International Colored Gemstone Association (ICA), Israel Diamond Institute (IDI) and Taiwan Pavilion, apart from the existing Thailand Pavilion and Korea Pavilion.

As the only jewelry exhibition that targets on local consumers, a series of rewarding activities and offers are held during the 4-day event, including a variety of pubic seminars, lucky draws, as well as exclusive sales discounts.



International Designer Arena

One of the highlights of this year's International Jewelry Manufacturer's Show is the International Designer Arena (IDA), where a wide range of remarkable and outstanding jewelry designs from all over the world is exhibited.

Steered by HKJMA since 2008, IDA provides a platform for haute jewelry artists to showcase their unique designs, at the same time exchanging ideas and inspirations. Designers across

the Asia Pacific, Europe and Americas have had the chance to present their masterpieces to an international audience. At this year's show, works from 30 jewelry artists are selected to exhibit in IDA.

Public Seminars

During the event, HKJMA has also arranged seminars for the public on the latest information of the jewelry industry, avoiding sales traps and becoming a smart jewelry buyer. This year, 6 seminars are hosted by experienced specialists across the Show, with topics include Gern, Jade, Pearl and Jewelry design. Don't forget to reserve in advance as admission is on a first-come, first served basis!

The Diamond Lucky Draw is another most anticipating activity at the Show. HKJMA is giving out a total of 5 carats Loose Diamonds this year. A lucky draw ticket is given to each
